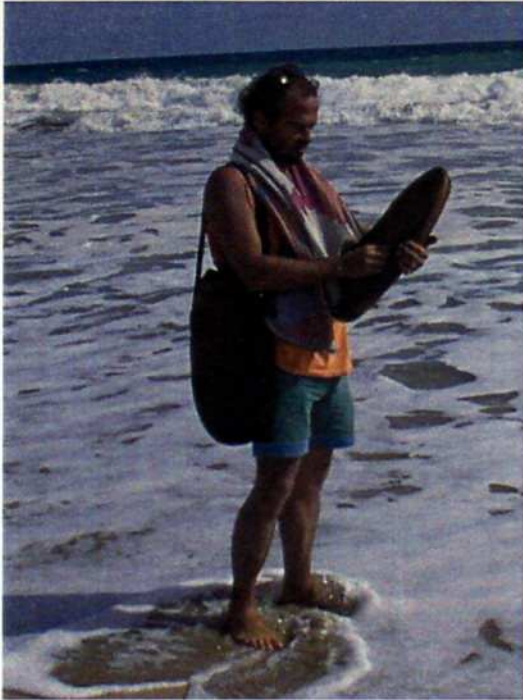
Ann's interests are travel, playing the piano, painting, writing, gardening and people (but not necessarily in that order).
